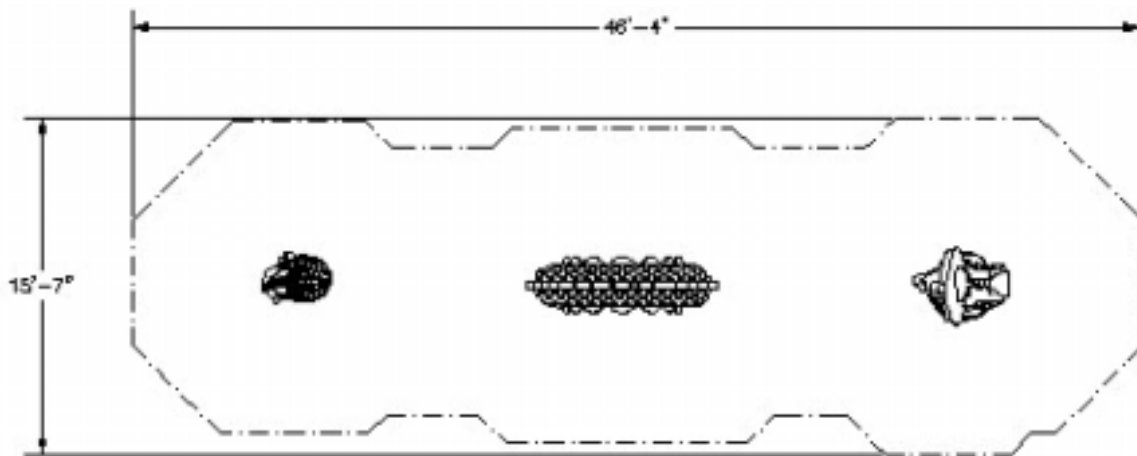

Dragon Challenge Design:



Dragon Challenge Specifications: the Dragon Head, Middle and Tail hoop shall be rotationally molded from linear low density polyethylene. The plastic components shall be connected to the ground using supports made from pre-galvanized 89 mm (3.5") diameter by 11 ga wall steel tube and pre-galvanized 11 ga sheet steel. Assembly hardware is stainless steel. The dragon challenge shall be mounted inground only.
